

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

For Filipino Students

An applicant for admission must accomplish the following:

1. Pass an interview to be conducted by the Program Dean
2. Pass the Discipline-based Admission Test to be administered by the Graduate School Office.
3. Submit the following:
 - 3.1 Admission Letter from Graduate School Office.
 - 3.2 Original or Certified True Copy of official Transcript of Records from the last school attended
 - 3.3 Certificate of Eligibility to Transfer / Honorable Dismissal
 - 3.4 Philippine Statistics Authority Authenticated Birth Certificate
 - 3.5 Philippine Statistics Authority Authenticated Marriage Certificate (for female married applicants only)

For Foreign Students

INITIAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Letter of Intent to Study at LPU-Batangas
Send it via email: registrar@lpubatangas.edu.ph. Please attach the following scanned documents:
 - School Records (from the last school attended)
 - Copy of Passport (Bio page)
 - Birth Certificate
 - Police Clearance
 - Affidavit of Support/Proof of Financial Capacity, like Bank Certificate or Bank Statement (for the latest 6 months)

After verification and evaluation of the above documents where the same are deemed to be compliant, a Letter of Invitation/Acceptance will be sent to the applicant for him/her to process appropriate Admission Visa.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Passport with Bureau of Quarantine Stamp
- 6 pcs. 2 x 2 ID pictures with white background
- Authenticated copies (Red Ribboned by the Embassy) of the following documents:
 - School Records (from the last school attended)
 - Thesis Abstract in English (For Doctorate/PhD students only)
 - Medical Records
 - Birth Certificate (original copy)
 - Police Clearance/NBI Clearance (For walk-in applicants)
 - Affidavit of Support/Proof of Financial Capacity, like Bank Certificate or Bank Statement
 - Letter of Invitation/Acceptance from LPU-Batangas
- Entrance Examination Result
- English Proficiency Test Certificate. (For foreign students from Non-English speaking countries.)
